BYLAW NO. 702

A bylaw to establish fees for commercial water taxis using the Langdale dock

WHEREAS the Sunshine Coast Regional District has established a service for the purpose of providing public access to the Langdale dock;

AND WHEREAS the Board wishes to establish a fee for commercial water taxis using the dock;

NOW THEREFORE, the Sunshine Coast Regional District Board in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:


CITATION

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Langdale Dock Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 702, 2016".
2. No commercial water taxi may use the Langdale dock unless they first:
 - (a) pay an annual fee of \$600; and
 - (b) complete a sublicense agreement in the form established by the Sunshine Coast Regional District.
