

DRAFT “Source Assessment Response Plan” - Public Feedback Form

The Sunshine Coast Regional District has partnered with the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority to develop a Source Assessment Response Plan (SARP) for the Chapman Creek drinking water watershed.

The purpose of the SARP is to enhance protection of drinking water in the Chapman watershed by minimizing risks to drinking water quality. The SARP has been developed with an understanding that, under current Provincial Legislation, eliminating industrial related risks altogether is not an option at this point.

The latest draft of the SARP is now available for public comment, and this feedback form is one way you can provide input before final revisions to the document are made.
