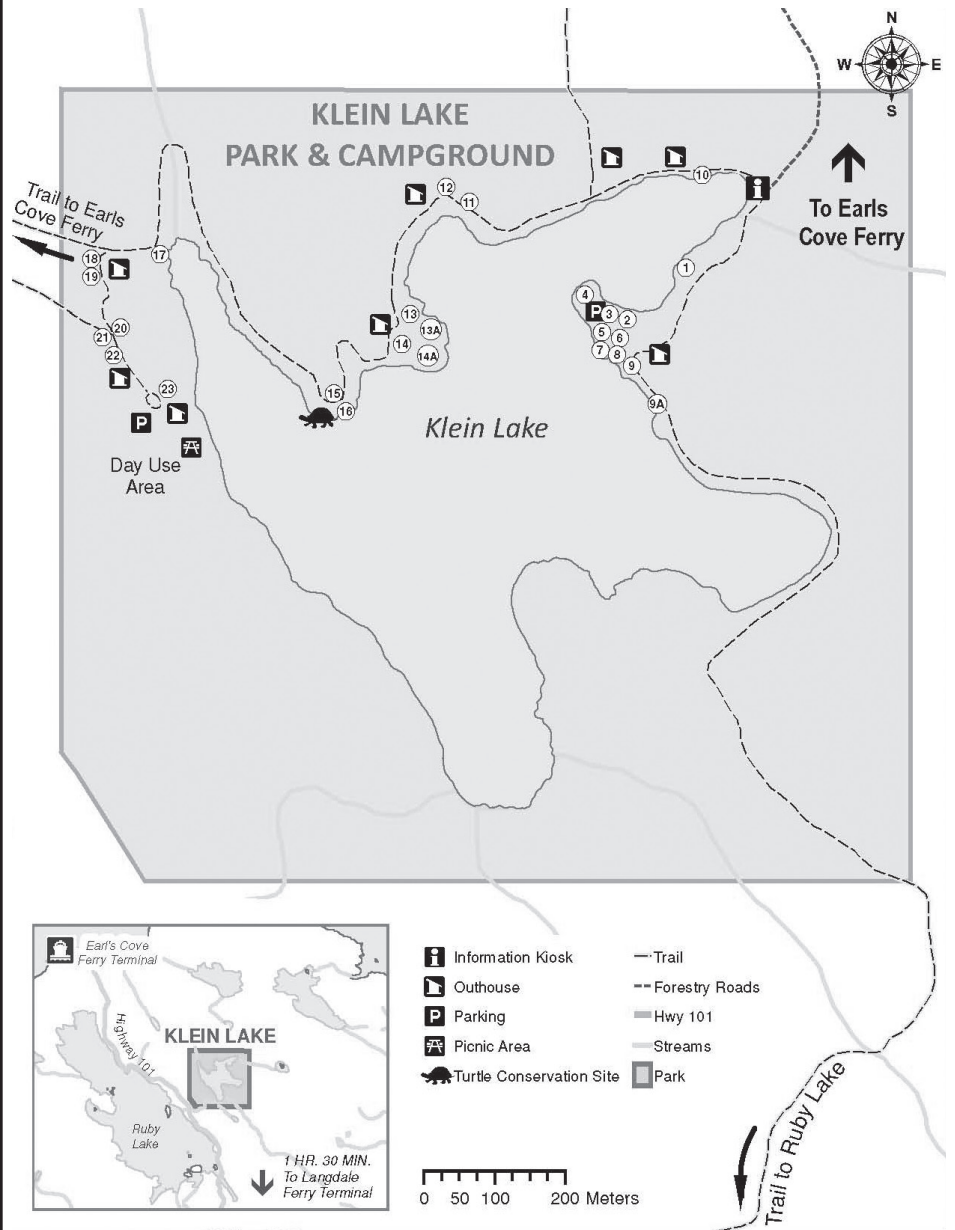


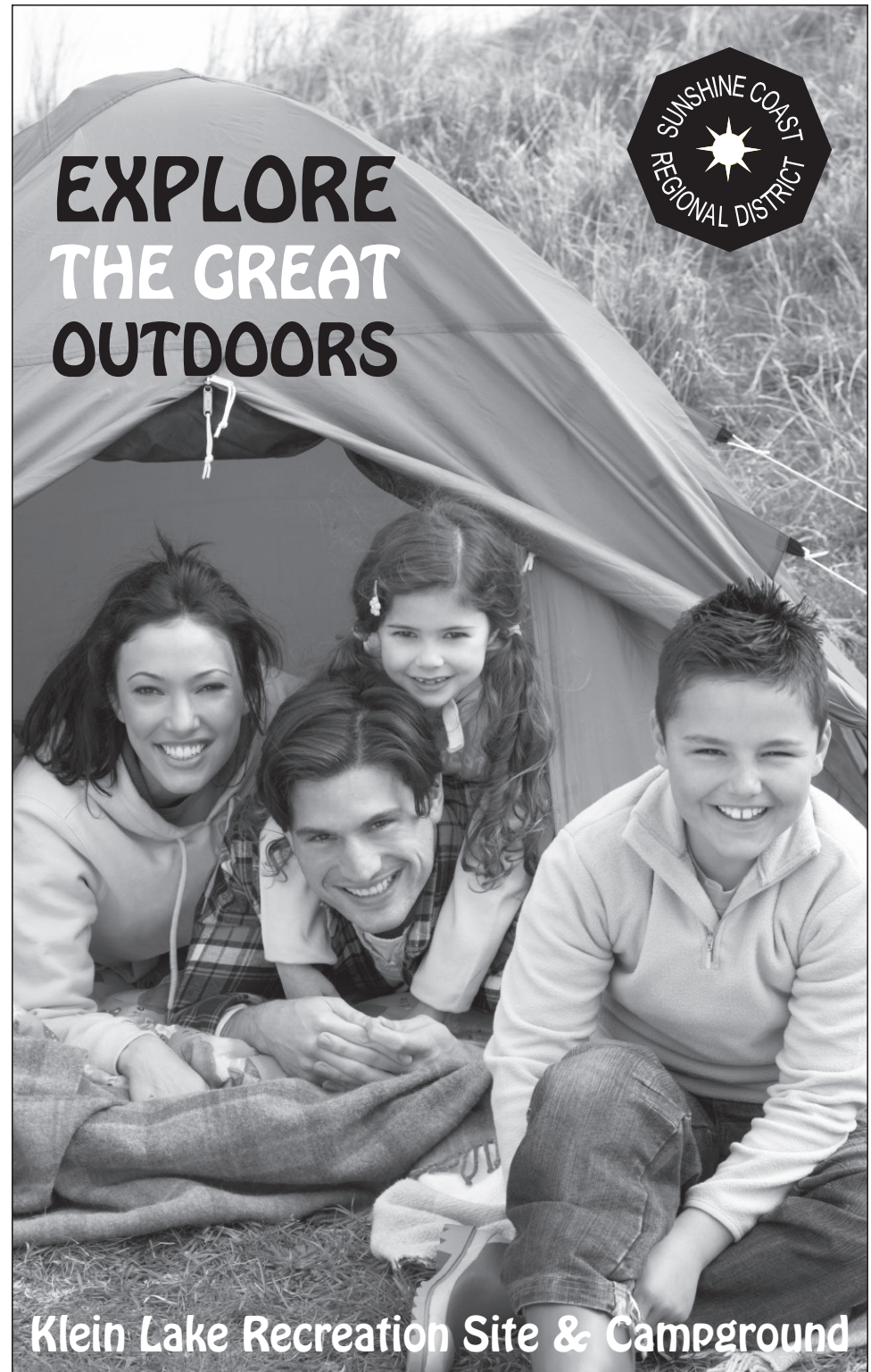
Campground Map

CAMPING WITH YOUR FAMILY HAS NEVER BEEN EASIER

The Klein Lake Recreation Site and Campground is managed by the Sunshine Coast Regional District (SCRD) through an agreement with the Ministry of Forests. The SCRD has a stewardship agreement with the Egmont Community Club to manage the campsite and collect fees as set by the Ministry of Forests.



Amenities

Klein Lake Campground is a popular camping spot with 25 tenting sites, smaller RV sites (sites do not allow for RV hookups and there are no sanitation flush facilities), public toilets, and a day use picnic area. One campsite and toilet facility is wheelchair accessible.

Dogs

Dogs are not allowed on the beach and in the swimming area.



Turtle Conservation

Klein Lake is home to an endangered Western Painted Turtle population. Please do not interfere with the turtles and their habitat.

Camping

Camping season runs from the May long weekend to the October long weekend. A person or group under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a legal guardian or parent. Campground information is available at the park entrance and from the caretaker.

Garbage

Please pack out what you pack in. Holding tanks should be emptied at sanitation facilities which can be found at most Provincial Park campsite locations.

Campfires

Campfires should not be lit during strong winds and must be attended and kept small at all times. Please extinguish your campfire before leaving and do not cut trees or remove firewood.



Drive Cautiously

Roads are often used by visitors as paths and play areas, so please respect the maximum speed limit of 15 km/hour. Do not drive over the vegetation.

Parking

Parking is available in designated areas. Keep roads clear, do not block traffic.

Vehicle Policy

There is a maximum of one vehicle per party, unless the vehicle is towed or is a commuter vehicle. All other vehicles require payment of an additional camping pass. Vehicles and ATVs must be kept on roads, parking areas and campsites.

Procedures and Reservations

Please check availability at the attendant's site. A camping permit is required for overnight use of this facility and fees will be collected by an attendant at your campsite. Fees are used to provide maintenance and supervision at this site. Checkout time is noon.

Courtesy

Please respect the peace and quiet of others. Keep your noise to a minimum at all times. Designated quiet time is from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Rates

Daily fees are \$12 per party. There is a maximum of six people per campsite unless you are a family. Fees are payable in advance.

Other

Hunting or firearms are not allowed in the park. Gas powered boats are not permitted on the lake.
