SCRD Emergency Operations Centre Update #3 – Boil Water Notice

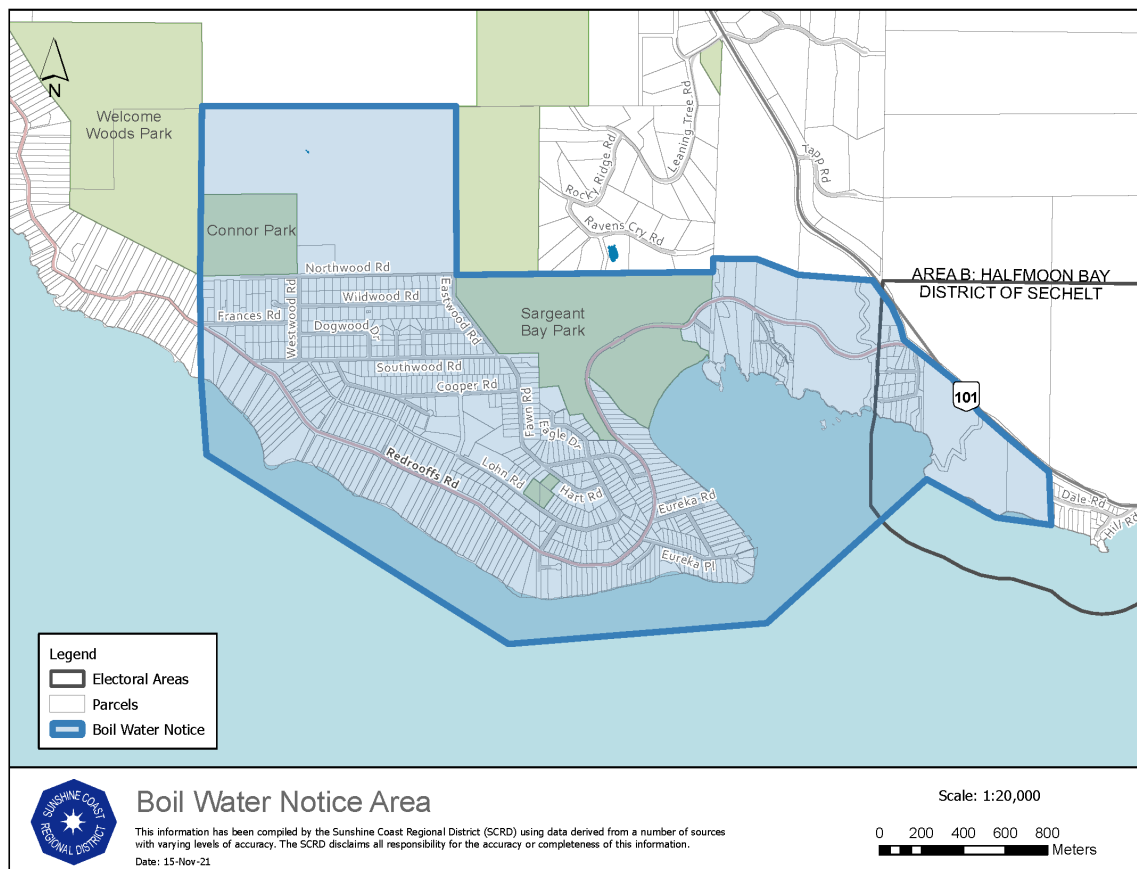
Sechelt, BC – November 15, 2021— The SCRD has activated an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to assist in coordinating resources as we deal with a number of water / flood related issues in the Region.

This is update #3 at 1:30 p.m.

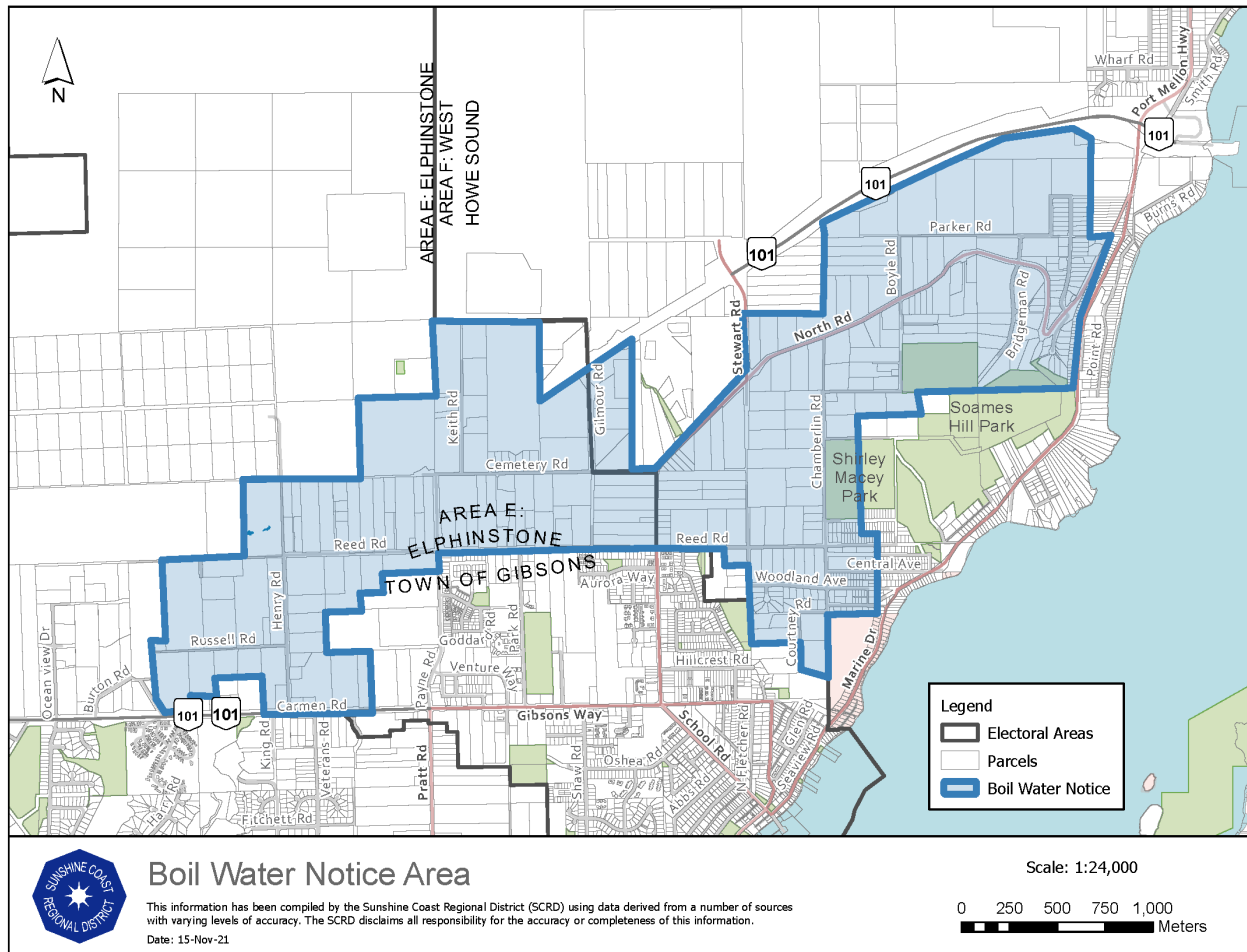
The SCRD is advising all water users in the areas outlined below area to boil their water before using it for drinking, cooking, washing food, or brushing teeth, due to a potential problem with washouts of water mains and loss of protective pressure in the water system.

The boil water notice is in place for water users in the areas outlined in maps below.

The water can be made safe by boiling it for one minute at a rolling boil. Boiled water should be stored in a clean container in the refrigerator.

Alternatively, bottled water can be used.

You will be notified when service is returned to normal and the water is again safe to drink. Thank you for your co-operation.
