RE: **NOISE BYLAW VARIANCE – BC FERRIES BERTH REPAIR**

RECOMMENDATION

THAT enforcement against BC Ferries under *Sunshine Coast Regional District Noise Control Bylaw No. 597, 2008* be waived from April 15-19, 2013 in order for repairs to be made to Berth 1 at the Langdale Ferry Terminal, with minimal disruption to services;

AND THAT staff be authorized to act on this recommendation immediately.

BACKGROUND

BC Ferries has requested a variance to the Noise Bylaw from April 15 to 19, 2013 between 8:30 pm and 5:00 am in order to make urgent repairs to Berth 1 at the Langdale Ferry Terminal.

DISCUSSION

Berth 2 will be used while Berth 1 is closed for repairs. This may impact schedules, as loading and unloading speed will be impacted by the need to use the articulating ramps on the ferry. In order to minimize the inconvenience to travellers, BC Ferries is proposing to make the necessary repairs at night. This will enable the work to be concluded in five days instead of three weeks, but the noise will have some impact on neighbours.

BC Ferries has advised that they intend to manage the project so the loudest work (i.e. cutting steel) will be done before 11:00 pm; however there will be noise from workers, welding and use of a crane after 11:00 pm.

Should the variance be denied, work would be done over a three week period and the travelling public will be impacted for a longer period.

If the Committee supports work on Berth 1 being done during normal 'quiet hours', a resolution can be passed to indicate that enforcement of the Noise Bylaw will not be undertaken during the specified time period.
