Sechelt, BC – August 30, 2021 – The Sunshine Coast Regional District (SCRD) has released its 2020 Annual Report, providing an overview of how the SCRD adjusted to the COVID-19 pandemic to sustain operations and made significant progress on Board strategic priorities.
