



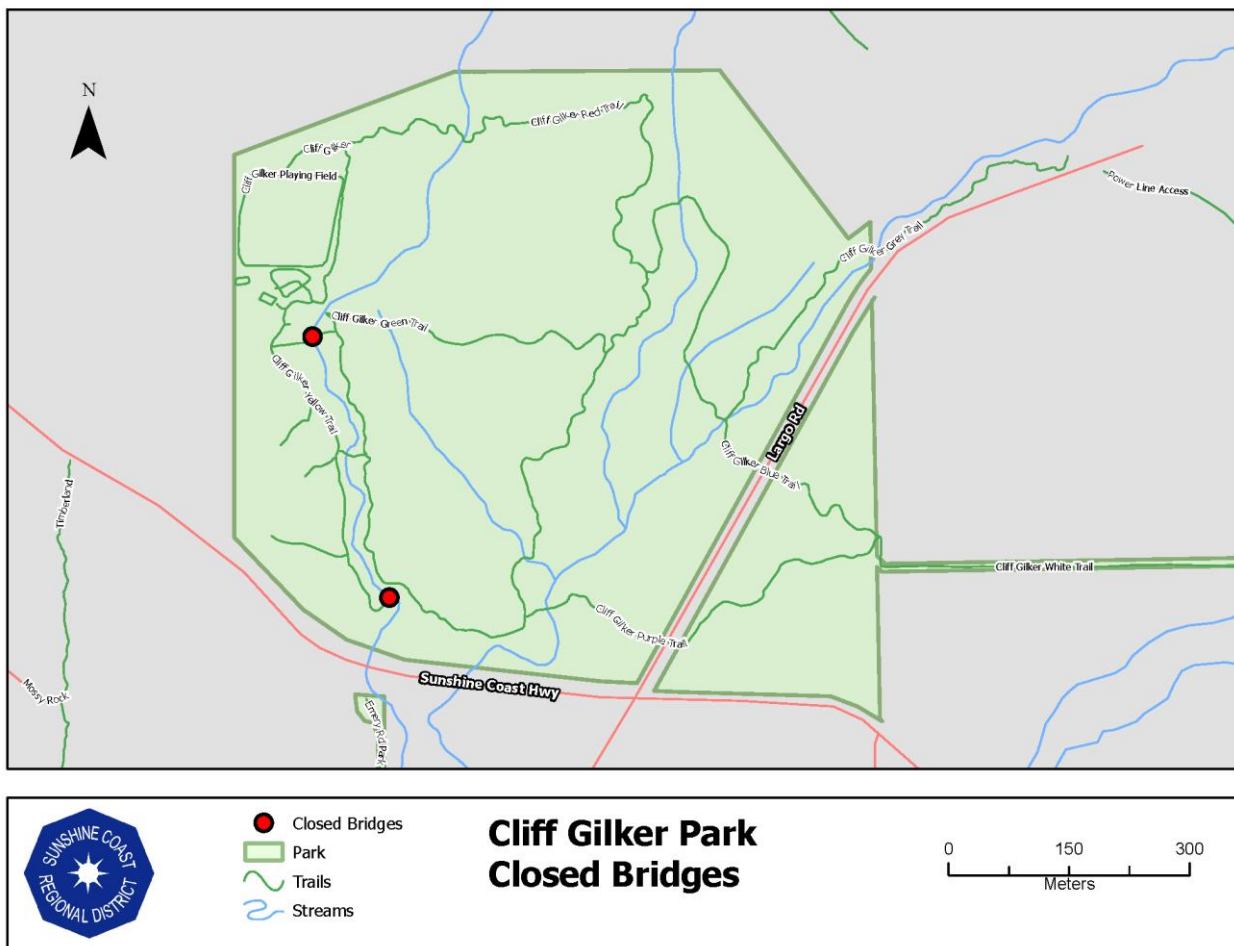

Cliff Gilker Park Reopens

Sechelt, BC – December 3, 2021 — Since mid-November, SCR D parks staff have been working toward reopening Cliff Gilker Park after bridges and trails in the park were damaged in the recent flooding event that hit the Sunshine Coast.

Today the park is back open, with some changes.

The flooding event caused substantial damage to two bridges in the park. These bridges, and trails leading to the bridges have been closed off and are highlighted below in pictures and a map. **These closures are for public safety and you are asked to respect them.**





Stream flows are still high and fast moving at Cliff Gilker Park. The public is asked to be careful when walking on trails near these streams.

“We know how important Cliff Gilker Park is to our community. Thank you for your patience while our staff have been working to get us to a point where we can safely reopen the park,” says Shelley Gagnon, General Manager of Community Services. “I want to also thank our staff for all their efforts to date. There is still a lot of work to be done in the park as we continue to assess damage from the recent flooding event and we appreciate the community’s cooperation with these bridge closures.”
