Curbside Garbage Collection Schedule Change On its Way

Sechelt, BC – July 19, 2021 — As of this August, the garbage collection company contracted by the Sunshine Coast Regional District (SCRD) will be implementing a change in the collection schedule to provide more efficient service.

The schedule will be adjusted to a new week and will affect half of residences within the SCRД curbside garbage collection service area.

“The day of the week that your garbage is collected will not change - only which week to place garbage out,” says Robyn Cooper, Manager of Solid Waste Services. “Garbage is still collected every-other-week and the Green Bin collected weekly.”

The SCRД will now have a week 1 and week 2 schedule for garbage collection. Residents will need to know whether their address falls under week 1 or week 2.

Residents can also sign up to receive personalized curbside collection service notifications by text, email or phone using the SCRД Collects App.

Waste Management, the curbside collection service company, will also be placing notices on affected resident’s garbage bin the week of July 26.

“Residents should be prepared for different collection times as drivers adjust to their new routes and your patience during this transition is greatly appreciated,” says Cooper.
