### SCRD Rentable Spaces and the B.C. Restart Plan

Sechelt, BC – June 29, 2021 — Since it was announced by the Provincial Health Officer that COVID-19 restrictions are to be eased through the Summer, the Sunshine Coast Regional District's (SCRD) Recreation Services team has experienced an increase in enquiries from our community looking to rent SCR D spaces for an event or gathering.

The SCR D Recreation Team continues to follow all public health guidance and is working diligently to ensure that facilities and rentable spaces reopen safely and in compliance with all public health orders.

At this time, the SCR D is asking that if you are looking to book an event, at a space managed by the SCR D that you do the following:

1. Check the B.C. Restart Plan for guidance on when you may be able to hold your event, paying particular attention to the number of attendees allowed - <https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/covid-19/info/restart>
2. The SCR D recommends booking your event for at least one month after the earliest date of when the applicable restrictions related to your proposed event are to be lifted. So, for example if certain restrictions were to ease today, June 29 then the SCR D recommends booking your event for July 29 or after.

"We are excited to welcome our community back to our spaces and will do the utmost to ensure we can facilitate bookings," says Graeme Donn, Manager of Recreation Services. "We have all seen how quickly public health orders can be amended and our booking guidance is in place to respond to any changes that may come up."

The SCR D will continue providing updates as the B.C. Restart Plan is implemented in the Region.
