



EVACUATION ORDER

Sunshine Coast Regional District

November 16, 2021 - Effective Immediately

Pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the BC *Emergency Program Act* an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by Sunshine Coast Regional District due to immediate danger to life safety caused by: localized flooding, road wash-outs, debris flows, failure of water mains impeding access to clean drinking water and disposal of waste water.

Members of the RCMP and other applicable agencies may be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas:

- **2022 OCEAN BEACH ESPLANADE**
- **2016 OCEAN BEACH ESPLANADE**

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice or call **604-885-6800**.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.

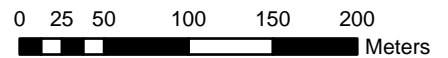
