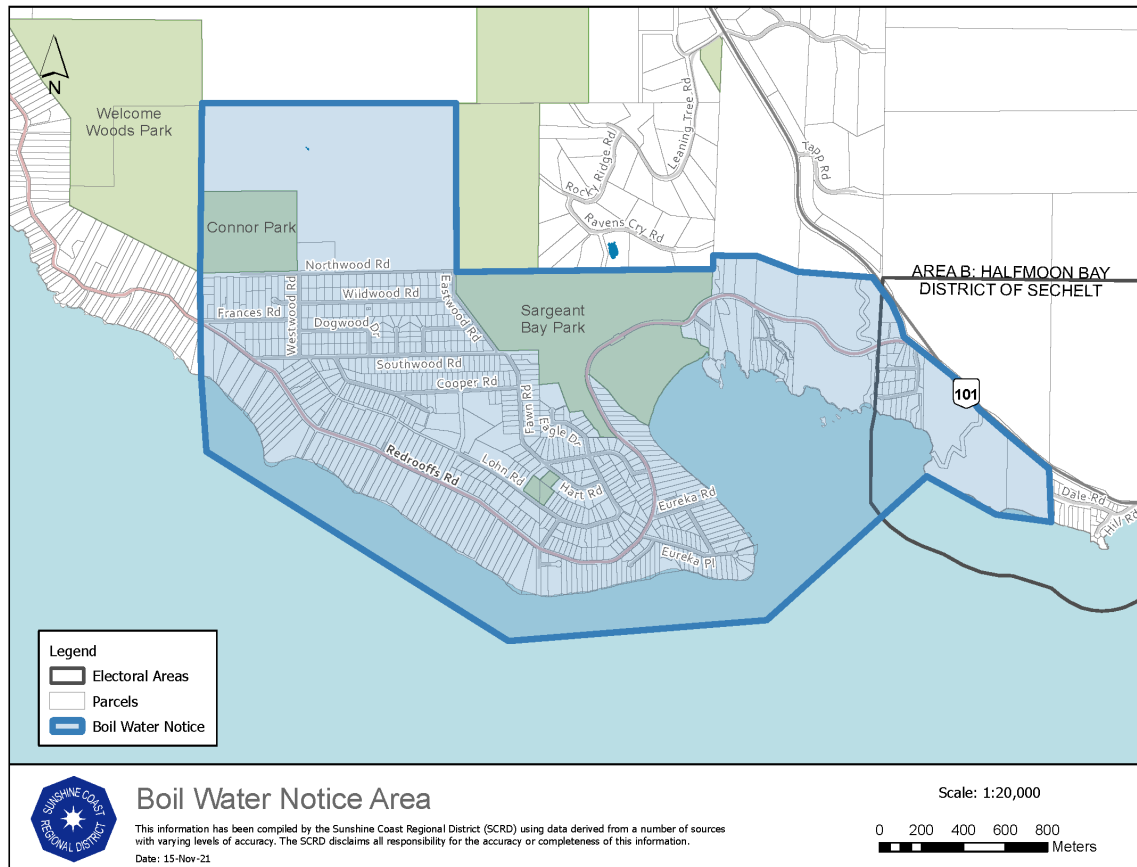
### SCRD EOC Update #7 – Water Service Restored in Halfmoon Bay

Sechelt, BC – November 15, 2021— The SCRD has activated an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to assist in coordinating resources as we deal with a number of water / flood related issues in the Region.

This is update #7 at 9 p.m.

SCRD crews have been onsite in the Redrooffs area of Halfmoon Bay for most of the day working to secure a water main. Water service will resume tonight for residents in the areas outlined in the map below. Please note that these **residences are still under a boil water advisory**.

The water can be made safe by boiling it for one minute at a rolling boil. Boiled water should be stored in a clean container in the refrigerator.

Alternatively, bottled water can be used.

You will be notified when service is returned to normal and the water is again safe to drink. Thank you for your co-operation
