Additional information on vaccination requirements for recreation

Sechelt, BC – November 2, 2021 – Last week, the Sunshine Coast Regional District (SCRD) outlined the impact of a [new Provincial Health Order](#) on recreation facilities. More specifically, vaccination requirements for those accessing certain activities at SCR D recreation facilities. You can read the [news release here](#).

Further information related to this Provincial Health Order has since been released which has provided clarity on additional vaccination check requirements at recreation centres.

- Any spectator attending an indoor sport activity at a recreation centre must show proof of vaccination. In the past, vaccination checks were required once a threshold of 50 or more spectators, aged 12 and over, attending was met. This threshold no longer exists.
- All participants in public skating and drop-in hockey programs must also show proof of vaccination.

Spectators arriving at recreation centres should expect delays when entering the facilities as staff will be checking for proof of vaccination, which must be accompanied by a corresponding I.D. Please note that youth aged 12-18 are not required to show valid government photo ID along with their proof of vaccination.
