Boil Water Advisory Lifted for Welcome Woods - SCRD EOC Update #14

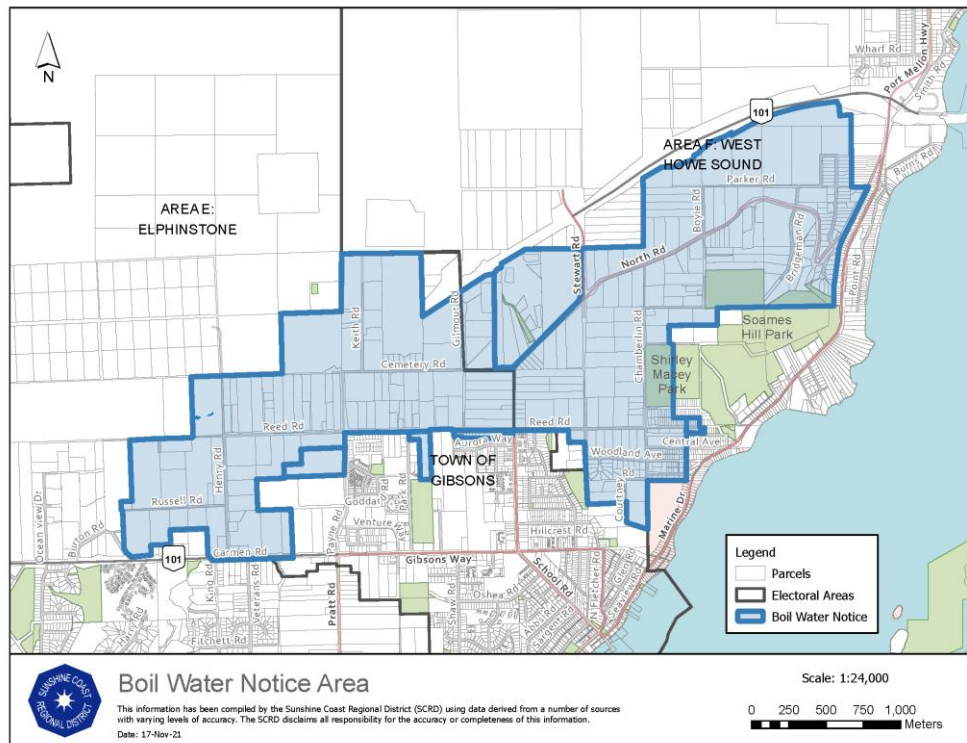
Sechelt, BC – November 20, 2021— The SCRD has activated an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to assist in coordinating resources as we deal with a number of water / flood related issues in the Region.

This is update #14 at 12 p.m. on Saturday, November 20.

Vancouver Coastal Health has advised the SCRD that testing of the water in the Welcome Woods area has shown that the water is once again safe to directly consume. **As such the boil water advisory for the Welcome Woods area only as shown [in this map](#) is no longer in place.**

The boil water advisory for the Gibsons / Elphinstone area outlined in the map below remains in place. It is anticipated that the boil water advisory for this area will be lifted early next week.

The water can be made safe by boiling it for one minute at a rolling boil. Boiled water should be stored in a clean container in the refrigerator. Alternatively, bottled water can be used.
