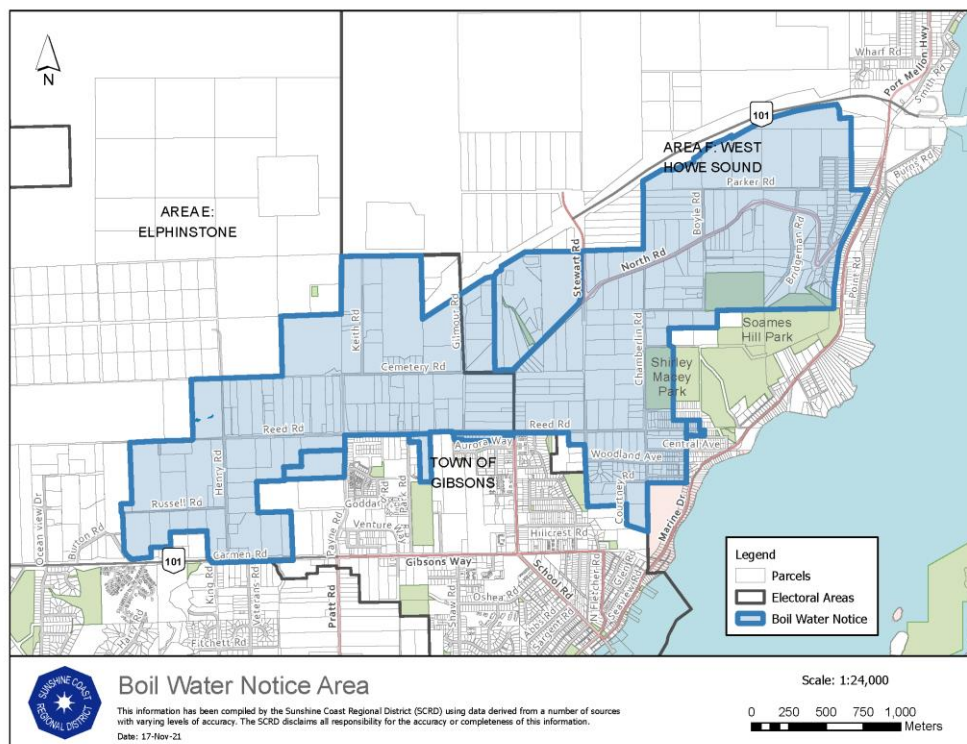
Boil Water Advisory Lifted for Gibsons / Elphinstone Area - SCRD EOC Update #17

Sechelt, BC – November 24, 2021— The SCRD has activated an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to assist in coordinating resources as we deal with a number of water / flood related issues in the Region.

This is update #17 at 11:15 a.m. on Wednesday, November 24.

Vancouver Coastal Health has advised the SCRD that testing of the water in the Gibsons / Elphinstone Area as referenced in the map below has shown that the water is once again safe to directly consume.

The SCRD would like to express our sincere gratitude for the patience of residents who have been affected by boil water advisories this past week.
