SCRD Emergency Operations Centre Update #18


Sechelt, BC – November 25, 2021— The SCRD has activated an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to assist in coordinating resources as we deal with a number of water / flood related issues in the Region.

The Sunshine Coast remains in an active State of Local Emergency which is currently set to expire at midnight on November 29, 2021. We are continuing to monitor the weather situation closely, with additional rain occurring now and into next week. There is an Evacuation Alert still in place for homes in the Ocean Beach Esplanade area. Here again, although reports are that conditions are improving, we will continue to monitor this area closely.

This is update #18 at 2 p.m. on Thursday, November 25.

Upcoming Weather

Environment Canada has issued a special weather statement for the Sunshine Coast. This statement can [be read here](#). A reminder to please check culverts in front of your home as they can quickly flood and cause significant issues in our Region. The graphic below shows which culverts are your responsibility. The culverts marked “Road maintenance contractors’ responsibility” are the responsibility of the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure and Capilano Highways on the Sunshine Coast. If you have concerns about a culvert **that is not on a property as shown** below then contact 604-740-0667. You can also contact your local municipality should you have concerns about blocked culverts near your residence
