SCRD Emergency Operations Centre Update #21

Sechelt, BC – November 30, 2021— The SCRД has activated an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to assist in coordinating resources as we deal with a number of water / flood related issues in the Region.

This is update #21 at 3:45 p.m. on Tuesday, November 30.

Upcoming Weather

The SCRД is monitoring the storm system currently affecting the Sunshine Coast. At this time, the Provincial Emergency Operations Centre (PREOC) has indicated that the Sunshine Coast is at low risk of being affected by the upcoming king tide.

Roads

The SCRД's EOC shares updates when they are available from the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI). The SCRД is not responsible for road repair and maintenance in the Region. At this time, the following is the most recent road information provided by MOTI.

- Lower Road at Stephens Road – Repairs continue and an estimated re-opening is not yet available.
- Beach Avenue at Margaret – Open
- Redrooffs at Cove Bay – Open

BC Transit

Route #4 Halfmoon Bay is back to full operation with service on Highway 101 and on Redrooffs. Road flooding continues to affect this route so please check the SCRД website for updates before you plan to travel.

Supply of Good and Services

The SCRД receives daily updates from PREOC and at this time there are no concerns over the supply of goods and services in the Region. We are grateful for the assistance of the community who have ensured that they are abiding by the provincial order to only fuel up to 30 litres per gas station visit.
