Cliff Gilker Park Reopened

Sechelt, BC – November 4, 2021 – This morning, BC Hydro contractors successfully removed a hazard tree that was hung up over the main access road into Cliff Gilker Park. The tree was located in close proximity to power lines and specialized contractors were required to remove it.

As of noon today, the park is back open. The SCRD would like to bring a few points to the public's attention before you access the park at this time.

1. Please be cautious when driving on the main access road. Repairs to the road bed are due to be completed next week.
2. There are a number of downed trees that are laying adjacent and parallel to the top of the access road, just before the main parking area. These trees have been flagged for visibility and will be removed shortly.
3. A bridge (pictured) was damaged by a falling tree on the red trail. This remains closed as staff work to repair the bridge.
