Intersection Closure & Water Shut Off Notice

Sechelt, BC—April 14, 2022— Water main construction is continuing for the Church Road Well Field Project and will result in further traffic disruptions early next week and a temporary water shut off.

Intersection Closure

The contractor for the project had advised the SCRD that they will be completing work at the intersection of Reed Road and North Road which will require the closure of the intersection.

In order to minimize disruption to highway traffic, this work has been scheduled to take place overnight, **between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. on Monday, April 18 and Tuesday, April 19**. The area affected is outlined in the map below.



Commuters are asked to consider taking alternate routes while construction is taking place. Drivers are asked to respect construction zone speed limits to ensure a safe working environment for construction crews.

Water Shut Off Notices

In order to facilitate the water main construction, water service will be shut off in two separate areas next week. These shut offs are outlined below.

Tuesday, April, 19 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Wednesday, April 20, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
