

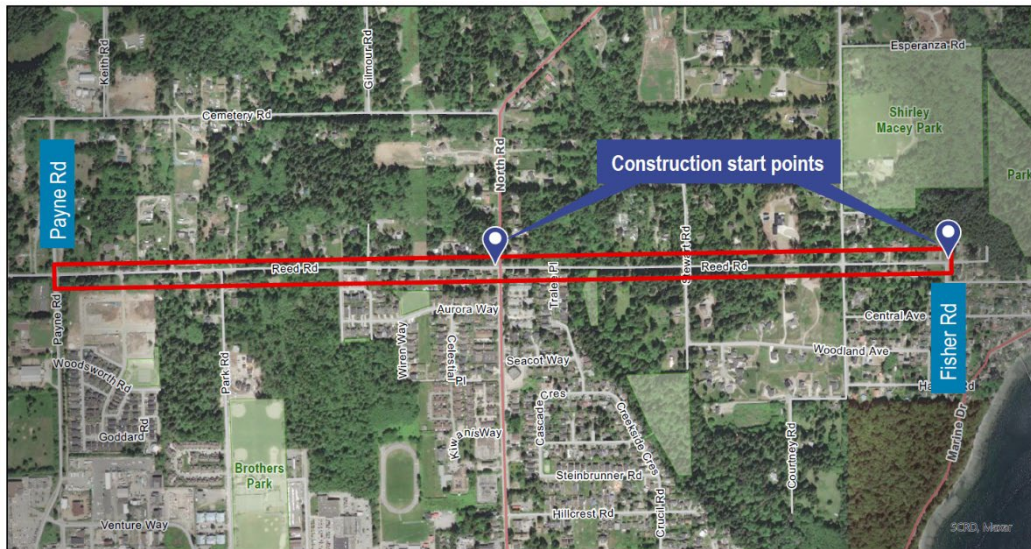

Church Road Well Field Project - Traffic Disruptions on Reed Road

Sechelt, BC—April 8, 2022— The next phase of construction of the Church Road Well Field project is set to begin and will result in traffic delays along Reed Road.

On Monday, April 11, water main construction will begin on Reed Road and is due to be completed by Friday, May 20. In order to minimize the duration of the disruption to residents and commuters in the area, two construction crews will be working simultaneously from Fisher Road on one side and from North Road on the other. The map below shows the area affected, which will be reduced to single lane alternating traffic for the full period of construction.



The contractor for the project, Maycon Construction will be in direct contact with affected residents. Commuters are asked to consider taking alternate routes while construction is taking place. Drivers are asked to respect construction zone speed limits to ensure a safe working environment for construction crews.
