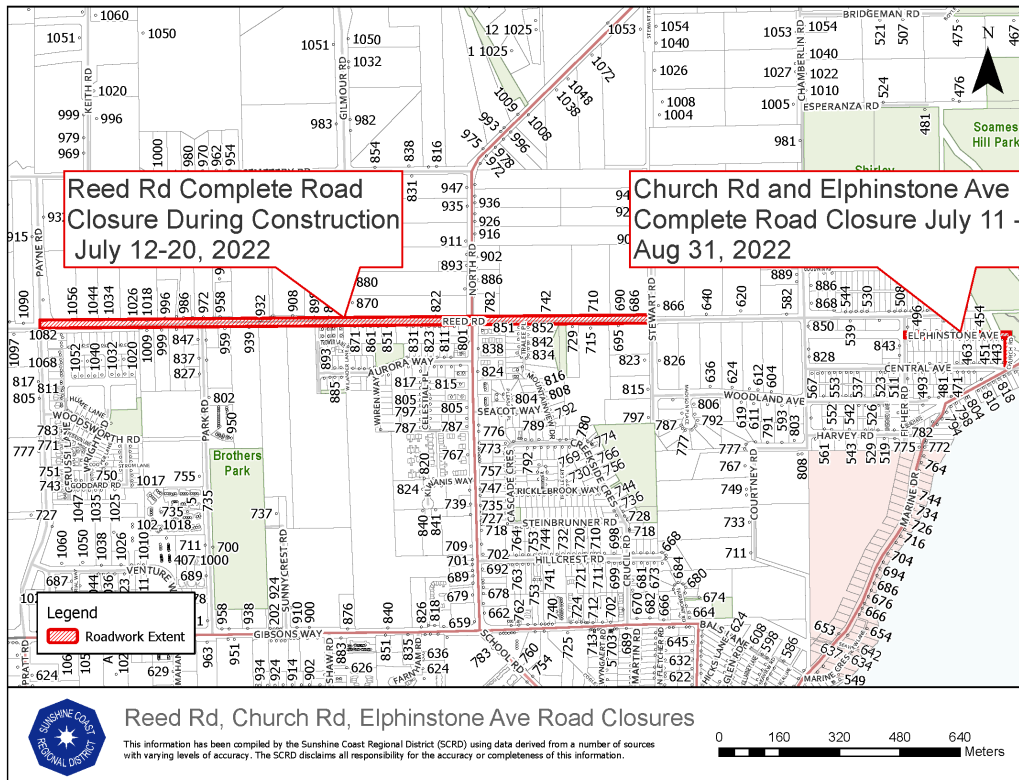
Church Road Well Field Project: Traffic & Curbside Collection Disruption

Sechelt, BC – June 30, 2022 – Paving and watermain construction will begin next week as the Sunshine Coast Regional District (SCRD) continues work on the Church Road Well Field Project. This work will result in traffic and curbside collection disruptions to local residents.

Traffic Disruptions

Next week, paving will begin on Reed Road. This paving will take place on both sides of North Road and is expected to continue until July 20th. Reed Road will be closed during construction but will reopen in the evenings after 7 p.m. when work has been completed each day. This closure is necessary as the road is not wide enough to allow traffic through while asphalt trucks and paving machines are doing their work.

Watermain construction will also begin on Elphinstone Avenue next week. This will result in full road closures. Motorists are urged to use alternate routes to avoid this impacted construction area.



Green Bin Curbside Collection

Construction on Elphinstone Avenue and Church Road will impact curbside Green Bin collection service for residents from July 4th - August 15th. Please bring your Green Bins to the end of Elphinstone Avenue at Fisher Road. For residents on Church Road, please bring your bins to the side of the road at Central Avenue and Church Road.

See the map below for the temporary collection area in orange. Use caution when placing your bins and do not place them in the way of traffic. To help keep track of your Green Bin we recommend putting your address on it.
