

## New Wood Waste Guidelines for Sunshine Coast Regional District (SCRD)

Effective November 13, 2019 the SCRD is changing the processor for wood waste.

**Residents who would have brought wood waste to the Sechelt Landfill, will now need to go to bring their wood waste to Salish Soils.**

This change will reduce emissions by keeping wood waste processing on the Sunshine Coast instead of shipping to off-coast processors. Reach out to Salish Soils for details on processing.

### **How does this change affect you?**

#### New location!

Salish Soils is located at 5646 Schetxwen Road, Sechelt  
Access the wood waste drop-off by Salish Soil's second gate, located further up Schetxwen Rd.

#### How much will it cost?

There are no changes to the SCRD's tipping fee, Salish Soils will collect and forward it on.

#### What about Pender Harbour Transfer Station?

Pender Harbour Transfer Station will continue to collect wood waste at the same tipping fees.

#### What will be considered clean wood and what is contaminated wood?

At Salish Soils and Pender Harbour Transfer Station staff will be screening for the

#### **2 redefined wood waste categories.**

#### **Clean Wood (\$170/tonne)**

Wood off-cuts

Wood with water based paint or stain

Composite wood products or wood containing glue

Nails or screws allowed

#### **Contaminated Wood (\$265/tonne)**

Wood that is not defined as clean wood

Pressure treated wood

Wood with oil-based paint or stain

Wood with any non-wood lamination

#### ***Creosote wood is NOT ACCEPTED.***
