

STOP LANDFILL FIRES BEFORE THEY START

We need your help to prevent fires at the Sechelt Landfill and Pender Harbour Transfer Station throughout the dry, hot summer months.

DO NOT put hot, flammable or explosive items in any garbage destined for the landfill or transfer station.

PROHIBITED ITEMS include:

- X **Hot Items** - ashes, BBQ briquettes and charcoal; they may still be hot enough to start a fire.
- X **Flammable Items** - lighter fluid, kerosene, butane, camping and stove fuel, gasoline, and DIY items such as oily rags, paint thinner, stripper, paint and varnish remover, turpentine, varsol, mineral spirits; they may cause spontaneous combustion.
- X **Explosive Items** - flares, propane tanks, aerosol cans, batteries (all types: single use, rechargeable, lead acid, lithium, etc.), ammunition; they may explode or combust when compacted.
