



# Rainwater Harvesting Rebate: Claim Form

Submit this rebate Claim Form within 90 days of receiving your pre-approval letter from the SCRD.

Applicants who are pre-approved for the Rainwater Harvesting Rebate must complete rainwater harvesting installation and submit a completed Claim Form within 90 days in order to receive the rebate. The rebate will only apply to storage vessels with a minimum of 4,500 liters of rainwater storage volume. ### 3. Rebate Claim\* (check one):

- Up to **\$1000** for installing a minimum of 9,000 litres of new rainwater storage

*\* The Rainwater Harvesting Rebate Program will provide a rebate for the purchase of rainwater storage vessels, up to the amount outlined above. Storage vessels purchased for less than the maximum rebate amount will receive a rebate for the cost indicated on the receipt, including tax.*

### 4. Tank (Cistern) Safety

Like swimming pools, water tanks can be dangerous for the children in your neighborhood as they are a drowning hazard. They also qualify as a confined space, and the air inside may not contain sufficient oxygen to allow a human to maintain consciousness. Please ensure you have taken all necessary precautions to ensure that your water tank is installed and operated safely.
