Stage 1 Water Conservation Regulations come into effect May 1.
Fine for infraction: \$200

ACTIVITY	REGULATION DETAILS
Lawns (<i>Sprinkler or soaker hose</i>)	Two days per week Thursday and Sunday for even numbered address. Wednesday and Saturday for odd numbered address. 7 am to 8 am (hand watering is permitted at any time)
New Lawns (<i>With permit</i>)	7 days per week 7 am to 9 am and 7 pm to 9 pm
Trees, shrubs, flowers (<i>Sprinkler or soaker hose</i>)	Three days per week Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday for even numbered address. Monday Wednesday and Saturday for odd numbered address. 7 am - 9 am and 7 pm - 9 pm
Trees, shrubs, flowers (<i>Hand held hose with nozzle, hand held container, micro/drip-irrigation</i>)	PERMITTED
Food producing plants and trees (<i>Sprinkler or soaker hose</i>)	Three days per week Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday for even numbered address. Monday Wednesday and Saturday for odd numbered address. 7 am - 9 am and 7 pm - 9 pm
Food producing plants and trees (<i>Hand held hose with nozzle, hand held container, micro/drip-irrigation</i>)	PERMITTED
Commercial farms	PERMITTED
Washing Vehicles or Boats	PERMITTED with container, hand-held hose with nozzle, or commercial car washes.
Washing sidewalks, driveways, windows, fences or exterior building surfaces.	PERMITTED with hand-held hose with nozzle, or pressure washer.
Filling swimming pools, spas, garden ponds, fountains.	PERMITTED
Public Sports Field	Restricted under separate schedule.

These regulations apply only to the use of treated drinking water not to the use of rainwater, private well water or any forms of recycled water.
