



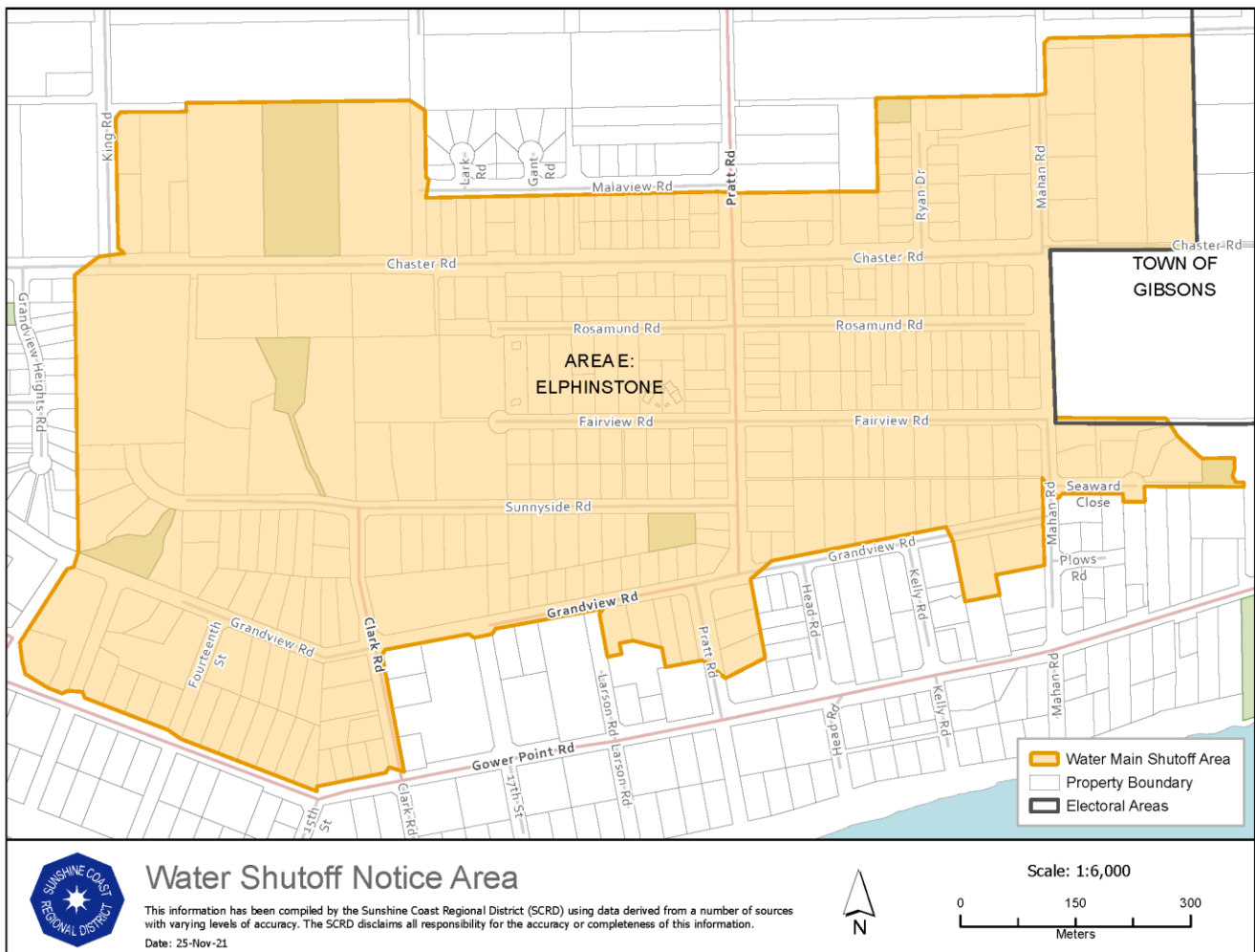

Planned Water Service Shutoff in the Chaster Road Area

Sechelt, BC – November 26, 2021— Work is continuing to upgrade vital water infrastructure on the Sunshine Coast with a new water main connection due to be installed in the Chaster Road Area of Elphinstone on Monday, November 29.

As a result of this important work, water service will be shut down for over 300 residences outlined in the map below on **Monday November 29. The outage is anticipated to last from 8:30am to 3pm. Please note that this work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled. Should this occur, updates will be provided at www.scrd.ca.**

Residents in the water service shutoff area should take measures which may be necessary to protect hot water units or other plumbing installations against possible damage. Ensuring you have a check valve on your water line, closing your private water shut off or flipping the electrical breaker to your hot water tank are ways to protect your hot water appliance. The Regional District accepts no liability for damage resulting from interrupted service.

You are also asked to fill containers with water prior to the service shut off to ensure you have water to use throughout the day.
