BACKGROUND

This report provides information on the activities of the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO).

DISCUSSION

Administration:

The CAO and staff are excited about the upcoming 2017 Community Dialogues across the Sunshine Coast. Community Dialogues are scheduled from Monday, May 8 to Saturday, July 8 at this point. 2016 Community Dialogues proved to be a good first step in strengthening our public engagement and staff look forward to continuing the opportunity to work more effectively with the community we serve.

All CAO's in BC have been requested to comment on the Responsible Conduct of Local Government Elected Officials paper. Staff have taken the time to prepare a thoughtful and knowledgeable response.

The CAO continues to meet and work collaboratively with SCRD Volunteer Fire Departments on various issues both regional and individual service based. More information on the various initiatives will be forthcoming over the coming months. The next meeting is set for May 25, 2017.

A staff working group has met to develop a plan to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the SCRD. There were no members of the public who expressed a desire to sit on the committee however, a few community members have expressed a wish to assist with one-time events. Staff have also integrated the Community Dialogues into the celebrations. A report will be forthcoming in May.

The CAO continues to meet with residents and community partners who are interested in learning more about the SCRD and/or have a concern and are seeking to be heard. Staff strive to be approachable, listen and assist in resolving their concerns.

- *"On the Go with the CAO"* was held in early April. Over 100 staff attended the various meetings. It was a good opportunity to meet staff in their workplaces and share corporate information and key initiatives.
