⇒ADD That the public be excluded from attendance at the meeting in accordance with Section 90 (1) (k) and (m) and (2) (b) of the *Community Charter* – "negotiations and related discussion respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public", "a matter that, under another enactment, is such that the public may be excluded from the meeting" and "the consideration of information received and held in confidence relating to negotiations between the municipality and a provincial government or the federal government or both, or between a provincial government or the federal government or both and a third party.".
