Applicants who are pre-approved for the Rainwater Harvesting Rebate must complete rainwater harvesting installation and submit a completed Claim Form within 90 days in order to receive the rebate. The rebate will only apply to storage vessels with a minimum of 4,500 liters of rainwater storage volume. Additional materials or installation fees, such as pumps and piping, are not eligible for the rebate. *For more information visit: scrd.ca/rainwater*
