You can hike, bike, camp, kayak, golf, do fiber arts, snowshoe, fish, scuba dive, walk the scenic trails in the amazing parks, windsurf or, as was portrayed in the former TV show on CBC, you could even get into some beachcombing here on the beautiful Sunshine Coast.

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is currently inviting applications for the position of Human Resources Assistant, Summer Student (Full-Time, Temporary). We are looking for a friendly and talented person to join our team and lend a helping hand over the summer season and possibly a bit longer! We are looking to provide some meaningful work experience that will include a variety of projects, exposure to a wide range of human resources (HR) management administrative and support services, and to assist in the delivery of various related programs and initiatives. The goal will be to supplement your classroom education with some In Real Life (IRL) experience.

This is an **exempt**, full-time, temporary position with a wage range starting at **\$28.48 per hour**. This position also includes 8% vacation pay, and an additional 5% in lieu of statutory holiday pay (after 30 days' employment). After 90 days' employment, this position is eligible for up to five (5) paid sick days.

Please note:

- Preference will be given to a student enrolled in a Human Resources program, looking to gain valuable work experience.
- > This is a temporary full-time position expected to last approximately 16 weeks.
- Some of the work can be completed remotely but there will be a need to actually work in the Field Road office at times and even touch some paper (I know so old school!) rather than just electronic data.
