- A separate certificate of insurance coverage for each registered professional may be required to be submitted with BC Building Code Schedule C after completion of the building but before a final inspection is made by the building official.*
- Confirmation letter must be signed by a registered professional. The BC Building Code defines a registered professional as a person who is registered or licensed to practice (a) as an Architect with the Architectural Institute of British Columbia under the Professional Governance Act, or (b) as a professional engineer or professional licensee engineering with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of British Columbia under the Professional Governance Act.*
