#### Item No.1

**Question:** I think it should be clarified that all disposal onsite will not have a cost associated with it. As per 01 74 19 Waste management & Disposal 1.6.b – Contractor will be charges the standard tipping fees for waste generated onsite as part of the construction works. I believe it was discussed at the Pre tender meeting that there would be no cost for disposal only the trucks were to be scaled in.

At both sites there will be no tipping fee, but the materials need to pass over the landfill scale and be weighed.
