SUMMARY: Under the supervision of the Facility Maintenance Coordinator, performs maintenance and repairs on SCRD facilities, including buildings and installations.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES include:

- 1. To perform routine maintenance on SCRD buildings and facilities as designated by the Facility Maintenance Coordinator.
- 2. To complete capital projects and ongoing repairs on buildings, fixtures and facilities to meet customer requirements.
- 3. To maintain records related to completion of work and submit workload data to the Facility Maintenance Coordinator.
- 4. To complete repairs or maintenance required for workplace safety or recommend action to be taken.
- 5. To comply with, and promote, safe work practices and procedures in order to support a safe and healthy work environment.

TYPICAL ACTIVITIES *include:*

- 1. Consults with facilities users to understand facility problems and recommend solutions to improve workplace efficiency, safety or comfort.
- 2. Prepares basic design sketches, cost estimates and performs repairs, restoration and improvements in response to work order requests.
- 3. Adjusts and/or completes minor repairs to heating, cooling, ventilating, plumbing and electrical systems.
- 4. Maintains all appropriate records relating to completed/pending work orders, labour and materials costs, and project completion.
- 5. Participates in the preparation of the department's annual report by providing statistics on completion of projects.
- 6. Maintains parking and walkway areas free of snow and ice.

QUALIFICATIONS, EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Completion of Grade Twelve (or equivalent).
- Ice Facility Operator Certificate or 5th Class Refrigeration Certification.
- Pool Operator Level 1 and Pool Operator Level 2.
- Completion of post-secondary education in building or facility maintenance preferred.

- Minimum of three (3) years' related experience in general building and property maintenance, specifically in conducting routine plumbing, electrical, carpentry, repairs and improvements and grounds work.
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence
