BACKGROUND

The Sunshine Coast Regional District is investigating the possibility of utilizing an existing on site well for the irrigation of the Cliff Gilker Sports Field. The field uses an estimated 4.8 million litres of water per year. Transitioning this field to a non-potable water source will result in increased water availability for the field and reduced use of drinking water from the Chapman Water System.
